



**Four Year-Old Preschool Registration**  
 January 2019

Dear Parents:

Anderson School District Five provides a great start for our youngest learners! Our program is available for income-eligible children who are four-years-old on or before September 1, 2019. The program is a full-day learning experience, following the regular arrival and dismissal times of your child's school.

Enrollment for the 4K Child Early Reading Development and Education Program (CERDEP) is non-discriminatory. In the event the number of income-eligible children exceeds the space available, additional children will be placed on a waiting list. All registered students will be baseline-tested using a school readiness screening tool. Upon registration, parents will be notified of the screening date and time for their child.

Registration for Anderson School District Five's 4K Child Early Reading Development and Education Program will take place **Tuesday, February 5, 2019 from 8:30 AM to 3:00 PM** at Homeland Park Primary School, North Pointe Elementary School, South Fant School of Early Education, West Market School of Early Education, and Whitehall Elementary School.

All 4K pupils are to register in the appropriate attendance area (See Chart Below). Students will register at sites using the current CERDEP zoning.

When parents come to register they must bring the following items:

- **Child's State Issued Birth Certificate** - The birth certificate issued at the hospital is not the legal birth certificate. Legal birth certificates may be obtained for children born in South Carolina at the Anderson County Health Department. Birth certificates for children born in other states may be obtained from the vital records department in that state's capital.
- **Child's Social Security Card** - If you do not wish to give us the social security number, a student identification number will be assigned to your child.
- **Child's Medicaid Card or Proof of Income** - If your child does not receive Medicaid, proof of income for both parent(s)/guardian(s) will be required. This includes step-parents if they assume responsibility. Proof of income can be W2 forms, income tax forms, or pay stubs.
- **Two Proofs of Residency** - Valid proofs of residency may include a current power, water, cable, or land-line phone bill, a lease agreement, or a contract on your house. A driver's license and cell phone bill are not accepted as proof of residency.
- **Legal Documentation (such as custody, court orders, safety plans, etc.), if applicable**

Completing the registration process does not guarantee a child's enrollment in the program. Due to the district's limited number of 4K programs, registration does not ensure a child's placement in a 4K program. However, a child cannot be placed in a 4K program unless he or she is registered and the school district has been provided with all the required documentation. If a child is registered on February 5, 2019 for a 4K program, a letter stating the status of the child's 4K application will be mailed to the parent/guardian on April 5, 2019.
