Parents and Guardians,

Good afternoon! In lieu of our open house for the 2021-2022 school year, the following changes have been made:

- All students will have access to their schedules beginning Friday, August 13, 2021. Students will also be given a hard copy along with other information on the first day of school.
- An e-mail will be sent out this weekend for you to meet your teachers virtually. The teachers have prepared a short video which includes an introduction and expectations for the upcoming school year. A map of the school with audible descriptions will also be provided.
- We encourage everyone to pay their school fees as soon as possible. All students must pay their technology fee of \$20. Material fees will range from \$15.00 to free, depending on if your child qualifies for free, reduced, or paid lunch. If applicable, be sure to complete the free/reduced lunch form in Registration Gateway or in the packet that will go home with your child on the first day.
- All parents should have received an email from our secretary, Summer Harbin, with an invoice for school fees. I strongly encourage you to utilize this feature to pay school fees. You will also have an opportunity to come by the school Monday, August 16<sup>th</sup> from 9:00-11:00 to pay fees, if you choose not to pay them online. Masks are required for entry. Let me reiterate, students will have access to their schedules Friday, August 13, so there is no need to make it a priority to come to the school to pick up schedules.
- A designated area will be assigned in the school where students can receive their schedules on the first day. This is only necessary if students have not checked PowerSchool for their schedules (as of Friday, August 13) and are unaware of their homerooms.
- All **sixth graders** will report to the auditorium on Tuesday, August 17<sup>th</sup> instead of reporting to homeroom. Students will receive assistance from staff in regards to finding the auditorium. Sixth graders will sit by homeroom teacher in the auditorium. At 8:10, I will welcome students, go over expectations, and release them by homeroom where they will receive a brief tour of the school and report to their homeroom classes.
- **Seventh and eighth graders** will report directly to their homeroom classes on the first day of school. (If you are earlier than 7:40 a.m., report to the gym). We will have more than enough staff to assist all new students in getting to their designated location, even new seventh and eighth grade students.
- While in homeroom, all students will receive information concerning classroom and school expectations.

On behalf of our faculty and staff, I would like to thank you for being flexible and understanding that our main priority is to keep everyone as safe as possible. Despite this moment of change, I am still confident that this is going to be a great school year.
