We have had a very successful 2017-2018 school year. I hope everyone has a relaxing and enjoyable summer. There will be a few changes for the 2018-2019 school year.

Below are some changes:

1. **Final Exam Exemption Policy** - Students will be exempt from taking their final exams, unless it is a state standardized test, during the first and second semester if they meet the following requirements:
 - A. Have a 90% or above class average with no more than four absences.
 - B. Have an 80%-89% class average with no more than two absences.
 - C. All absences count for exam exemption purposes with the exception of medical excuses, school activities, or absences meeting principals' approval.
2. **2019 T.L. Hanna High School Graduation**
 - A. Thursday, June 6, at 3:30 p.m. at Bon Secours Wellness Arena, Greenville, SC.
3. **Seniors Final Exam Schedule for the Second Semester and Graduation Practices**
 - A. Thursday, May 30 --3rd and 4th Block Classes (12:00-3:40)
 - B. Friday, May 31 --1st and 2nd Block Classes on (8:20-11:53)
 - C. Tuesday, June 4 --Graduation Practice at T.L. Hanna High School
 - D. Wednesday, June 5 --Graduation Practice at Bon Secours Wellness Arena
4. **Underclass Exam Schedule for the Second Semester**
 - A. Wednesday, June 5— Final Exams
 - B. Thursday, June 6—Final Exams
 - C. Friday, June 7 —Final Exam make-up day
 - D. No exams will be given early. Any student not present during the exam dates will receive a zero on their final exam. Students will have until June 26, 2019 to complete their final exam.
5. **Students cannot be checked out of School after 3:15**
 - A. To protect the integrity of instruction, T.L. Hanna High School will not dismiss students from class after 3:15.
 - B. Doctor, dentist, physical therapy and all other appointments should be scheduled during the summer, fall, winter, or spring break, and after school.
6. **Attendance**
 - A. Students must attend 85 of the 90 days for a semester course (170 out of 180 for a full-year course).
 - B. Students who fail for attendance (FA) will make up their time.
 - C. Attendance recovery will be offered using the following schedule and guidelines.
 - a. An hour of attendance recovery will equal one class period missed.
 - b. Saturday School, Teacher Professional Development Days, or Summer School will be used for attendance recovery.
 - c. The cost will be \$5 per hour.
 - d. Students must be on time and will be dismissed for misbehavior.
 - e. The fee is non-refundable.
 - f. All school rules will be adhered to including the school's dress code and electronics policy.
 - D. This year part of our grading policy will include a Participation Grade. The participation grade is 10% of the overall grade.
 - a. Students start with a 100% at the beginning of the semester.
 - b. Students lose two points per day for each absence or for early release.
 - c. Students can earn two points back by completing tasks as assigned by the teacher. We do understand students will be absent due to sickness, dentist appointments, doctor appointments, and other emergencies. That is why we afford students the opportunity to make-up the participation grade with an additional assignment or activity provided by the teacher.
 - d. The points do not reset at the end of the nine weeks. If a student has a 90% at the end of first nine weeks, they start the second nine weeks with a 90 % and the grade could continue to decrease.
 - e. Student must be present in class for a minimum of sixty minutes to avoid losing two points.
7. **Retaking Major Assessments (Unit Tests, Projects, Research Papers but not including Final Exams).**
 - A. Students may retake any major assessment one time.
 - B. The student must show that he/she has completed all of the daily assignments associated with that unit, as well as any remediation assigned by the teacher.
 - C. The teacher will average the two scores.
 - D. The student will have five school days from the time they received the returned graded paper.
8. **The Morning Brew** - This year we are pleased to announce the addition of The Morning Brew to our Media Center. Students may come by any morning to get tutorial assistance in math, science, or SAT/ACT prep in a relaxed atmosphere. We also welcome students that just want a quiet place to do their work. Bring your coffee in a covered cup and occasionally Mr. Tobin will provide coffee and hot chocolate.
