ABOUT THE CLASS

You already know the basics of art and have been exposed to multiple techniques and methods of artmaking. You should already have a working knowledge of art history. I have extremely high standards, and to do well in this course you must be dedicated and willing to work hard. This class isn't just to prepare you for a career in the arts, but to develop your **critical thinking** and **higher order thinking** skills, **practice time management, focus, discipline, and risk-taking**. That is what art teaches you.

In this class you will be presented with several project options each month, and you choose which you wish to do. You will be working independently of your classmates; everyone may be working on different projects at the same time. Through the guided projects you will practice the method of inquiry, investigation, practice, experimentation, revision, communication, and reflection.

EXPECTATIONS

- Use inquiry based learning to choose and develop projects.
- Analyze and speak about art using the conventions of art criticism.
- Reference art and artists from different cultures and time periods that inspire and relate to each project
- Every student is responsible for photographing, editing, and uploading work to the website or portfolio space.
- Meet all homework and project deadlines.

POLICIES
