What We're Learning

Reading

- We are learning to retell the central idea and key details from multi-paragraph texts.
- We are learning to recognize the differences between the points of view and perspectives of the narrator and various characters. We are learning to ask literal and inferential questions to determine meaning.
- We are learning to answer literal and inferential questions to determine meaning.

Writing

- We are learning to explore print and multimedia sources to write opinion pieces that introduce the topic, state an opinion and supply reasons to support the opinion, use transitional words to connect opinions and reasons, and provide a concluding statement or section.

Math

- We are learning to demonstrate fluency with addition and related subtraction facts through 20.

Spelling Words

We will be focusing on spelling words with final blends this week. Your child's spelling test will include these 6 words that follow that spelling rule. Their spelling test will also include 4 words that are not practiced this week. Those 4 words will follow this week's spelling rule. This is to assess that students are learning the spelling rule and not just memorizing the spelling of words.
