REGISTRATION GATEWAY:

Information regarding re-enrolling your student through Registration Gateway was mailed home with the end of the year report cards. Please complete this process prior to attending registration. Registration Table Information

Table #1 Express Lane: Students/parents who have pre-paid and submitted any required paperwork can pick up their student ID, parking hang tag, and schedule all together.

Table #2 Lunch Prepay Table: Anyone wishing to prepay for student lunches can pay at this table.

Table #3 Student ID's:- Students/parents will need to pick up their 2016-2017 T.L. Hanna School ID and lanyard.

Table #4 Parking: Students/parents can pick up or turn in the signed parking registration form. All outstanding fees must be paid before a parking hang tag will be issued.

Table #5 Yearbooks: Students/parents can pre-order or get information about the 2016-2017 T.L. Hanna yearbook.

Table #6 Student Council: Students/parents will be able to get information about T.L. Hanna's student council. Current members of Student Council (STUCO) will be available to help students find lockers, classrooms, and school tours.

Table #7 Athletic Booster Club: Students/parents can get information about the athletic programs at T.L. Hanna High School and sign up to become members of the T.L. Hanna Booster Club.

Table #8 Tri-County Technical College Talent Search: The mission of the Educational Talent Search Program is to assist students in reaching their academic potential to continue on to postsecondary education.

Table #9 The CHILL: Students/parents will have the opportunity to get more information about The CHILL (Christ Has Infinitely Lasting Love).

Table #10 Parent Volunteer Signup: Parents who are interested in getting involved or volunteering at T.L. Hanna High School can get information and sign up.

Table #11 Student Schedules and Outstanding Fees: Once a student/parent has visited the student ID table they may pick up their schedule and outstanding fees statement at this table. If parents or students have questions about their schedules, the guidance office will be open. Parents may sign up for conference times from 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-4:00.

Table #12 Calculator Rental: Students/parents will have an opportunity to get information and complete paperwork to rent calculators for student's math course.

Table #13 Student Fee Table: Students/parents bring their schedule and fee statement to this table to get a complete fee statement including current fees.

Table #14 Payment Table: Students/parents bring their completed fee statement to this table to pay for parking hang tag, yearbook, calculator rental, and student fees.

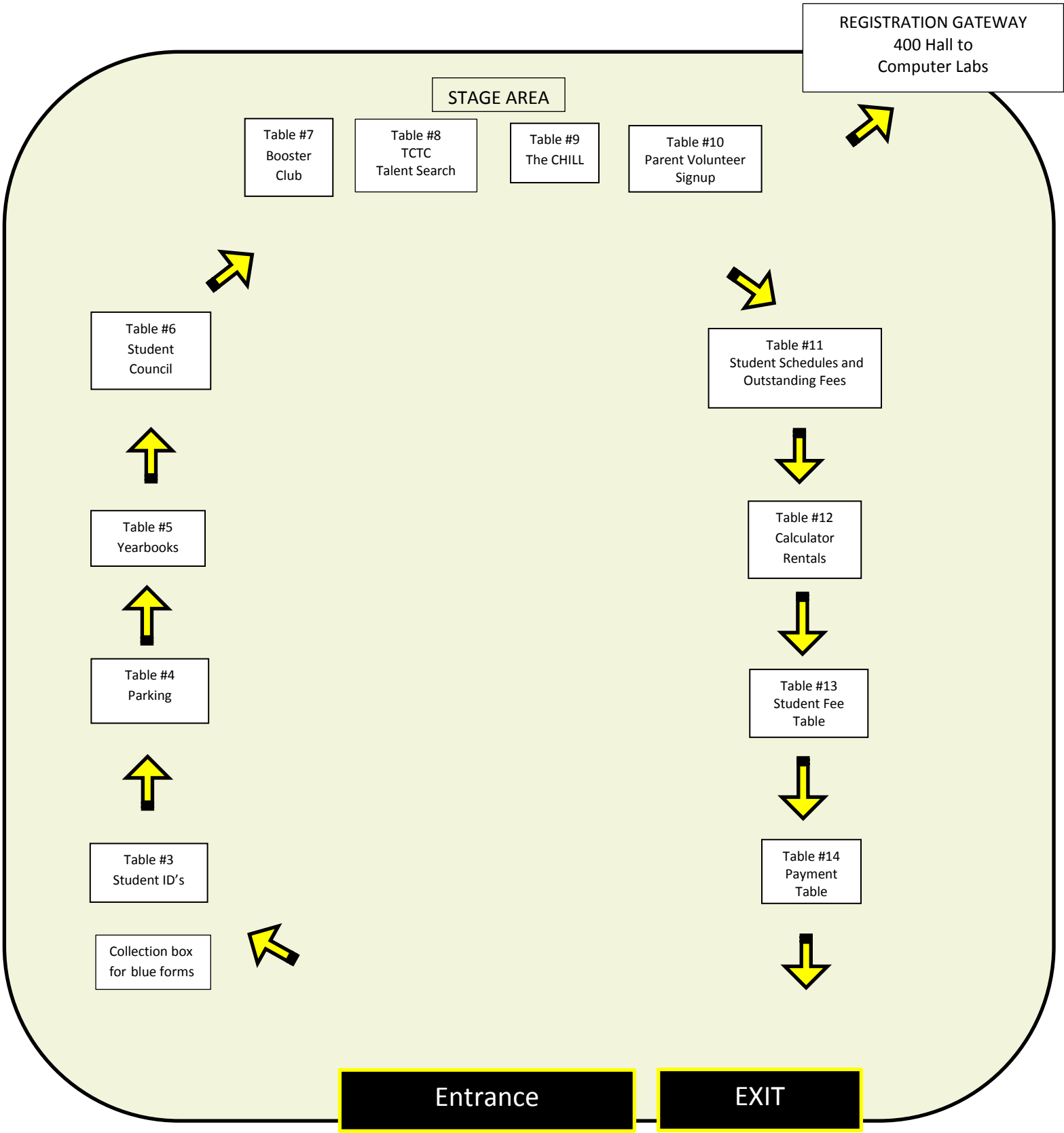


Table #2 Lunch Prepay Table
